Tennis

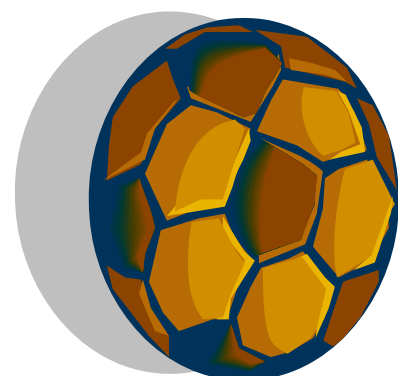
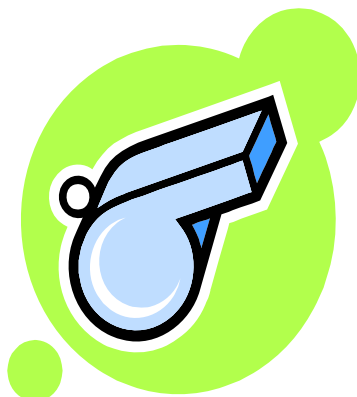
We have chosen tennis this week .
