Terms and Conditions

1. School Transport Services (STS), as agreed with the Management of Repton School will operate the buses for the transportation of their students with effect from 01st September 2009.
2. STS will comply with the rules and guidelines of regulatory authorities.
3. The STS drivers are fully trained and hold 'School Bus Driver Permit'. They also undergo regular training programmes conducted by the STS Training Team.
4. All buses have designated pick up and drop off points.
5. The transport fee covers pick-up and drop-off service only.
6. It is the responsibility of the parent(s) to ensure that their child is / children are at the pick-up point at the designated time. Buses will not leave from collection points ahead of schedule. However, due to traffic pressures, buses will not be able to wait at pick-up points after the scheduled time. Due to traffic delays buses may arrive at pick-up and drop-off points behind schedule.
7. Children up to Grade 2 will not be left at the drop off point unless the designated adult is present to collect them. Adults designated to pick up children should carry photo ID in the event that verification of identity is required. We would recommend that children up to Grade 4 are collected by the parents from the drop off points; otherwise a written consent from the parent authorising to drop off the child should be submitted.
8. Written request, signed by the parent/guardian, for reasons of safety and security, is required if a drop-off other than the usual point is requested.
9. In case of change of residence, provision of transport service will be subject to the availability of seats on established routes. Fees as applicable to the new pick up area as per the fee structure will apply.
10. All transport users should carry identity cards issued to them.
11. Transport service can be discontinued only at the end of the term (September – December; January – March; April - June) **with a two week's prior notice**. Discontinuation form is available at the website or at the school counter.
12. For safety reasons, eating and drinking on the bus other than water will not be permitted.
13. School Transport Services reserves the right to decline provision of service to the students in areas where it is not viable to operate the buses.
14. All vehicles of School Transport Services, drivers and passengers are insured. In case of any claim due to accident, the company's liability is limited to the comprehensive compensation paid by the insurance company, as per the terms of the insurance policy.
15. Parents or guardians shall compensate the company for any damages caused / sustained by the bus or other travellers as a result of inappropriate action by their child/children.
