BESPOKE CURRICULUM

At Repton, we pride ourselves on our ability to adapt and develop the curriculum to meet the needs of each pupil. With regular progress tracking through both formal and informal assessments, we deliver a bespoke and individual curriculum to ensure each student reaches their full potential.

EARLY YEARS

Our Early Years department offers the EYFS curriculum and focuses on developing enquiring minds by learning through play. The expertise of our outstanding teachers, well-resourced classrooms, dedicated outdoor spaces, garden, dedicated swimming pool, library and sensory room all provide opportunities to continuously develop the core seven areas of learning.

JUNIOR SCHOOL

Pupils progress through the Junior School following the British National Curriculum, they are taught traditional values of respect and good manners alongside an outstanding curriculum of academic, sporting and creative excellence. Our pupils develop their critical thinking skills and stretch their understanding through an exciting skill-based learning approach.

SENIOR SCHOOL

Our Senior School is designed to extend pupils' academic ability further, whilst encouraging them to think deeply, question and explore ideas for themselves. The expectation on all pupils is to take responsibility for their own learning and begin to carve their own future pathway.

IGCSE, A LEVEL & IB

The IGCSE offers a breadth of electives that caters to 21st century learning. Whether pupils choose to follow the A Level programme, the IB diploma or the IB careers programme, we are committed to ensuring pupils have the academic knowledge, skills and competencies to succeed and join their first choice university.



SPECIALIST TEACHING

We believe specialist teaching fosters exceptional achievement and attainment. Specialist teaching begins in the Early Years Foundation Stage in a range of subjects and increases as the children move up the school. From Year 5, all lessons are taught by specialist teachers. This ensures depth in the Repton curriculum in every year group and every subject, as well as smooth transitions between year groups and key stages. All our specialist teachers have expertise in a particular field, have specific qualifications to teach that subject to a high level and are passionate about it.

IMMERSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAMME

We encourage students who are new to learning English to enrol in our bespoke 'English Language Learners Immersion programme'. This programme is taught by a specialist English teacher, is planned around the student's class timetable and enables students language acquisition to be accelerated quicker so that they are confident to be able to access the full curriculum alongside their peers.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships at Repton are awarded to pupils in Years 5 - 8, and IB1/Year 12, both to internal and external candidates. They are tenable for the pupils' time at school, subject to high standards of behaviour, performance and engagement in all school areas. Years 5-8 scholarships are offered for Academics, Sports, Arts and Music excellence. IB scholarships are offered to pupils that excel in their IGCSE's.

INCLUSION

Inclusion lies at the heart of Repton's vision. We provide a fully inclusive environment that welcomes and values all children. We inspire excellence in all, whatever their age, ability, gender or background. Our dedicated Inclusion Department works in close partnership with parents to provide booster sessions for those who require additional support or curriculum extensions as part of our gifted and talented programme. This ensures teaching is suited to all individual needs, providing a personalised education that is bespoke to every child, enabling them to reach their full potential and beyond. English language support (EAL), Occupational Therapy and Speech Therapy are all also available to our pupils.

SPORTS

Repton offers a wide range of sporting opportunities to all pupils which are supported by our fantastic sports facilities. Our pupils have access to experienced sports professionals from Olympic athletes to UAE National players. Our teams are amongst the top five schools in the UAE across a wide range of sports for both boys and girls in all ages. In particular, our performances in core sports of Netball, Football, Cricket, Swimming and Rugby have been impressive and our teams routinely achieve top honours. Special mention to our U19 Girls Football team and U16 Boys Football team who were crowned DASSA Champions for 2018. Repton also competes internationally and has demonstrable success in sporting tours conducted in England, South Africa, Thailand and Spain.



BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

At Repton, learning can take a variety of forms and many of these take place beyond the confines of the classroom.

We emphasise the importance of engaging with other schools and societies, with pupils taking part in the UK Maths challenge, Model United Nations, FI in Schools and 4×4 challenges.

Repton provides an outstanding and ambitious programme of outdoor education from an early age, involving overseas trips, local adventure camps and leadership workshops such as the Duke of Edinburgh award.

Whether on top of a mountain in the French Alps, a community project in the jungles of Thailand or competing in Netball tournaments in South Africa, we ensure all of our activities develop essential life skills such as a team work, self-confidence, leadership and self-reliance that will set Repton pupils in good standing for the rest of their lives.

PASTORAL CARE AND WELLBEING

Along with placing focus on the academic successes of our pupils, we are immensely proud that the pastoral element of the Repton curriculum has been consistently awarded outstanding by the Knowledge and Human Development Authority (KHDA). The pastoral care of our pupils is central to our vision of nurturing the whole child at each stage of their emotional development. 












CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

IB PROGRAMME (IBI - IB2)

A LEVELS

A COMPREHENSIVE 2-YEAR, RIGOROUS ACADEMIC PROGRAMME, PREPARING PUPILS FOR UNIVERSITY EDUCATION

- The IB Diploma (IBDP) is a balanced, rigorous qualification that has been in existence for 50 years
- Pupils must take English, Mathematics, at least one Science, at least one Humanities subject, a World Language and then a further choice from the Arts or others
- CAS (Creativity, Activity and Service) points are awarded through a range of initiatives including trips, volunteering, or something of the pupils' own design
- This two year course will allow students to study four subjects, as well as having dedicated time to compete the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ).
- The A levels will conclude with examinations and assessments to determine the final grade upon completion of course.
- The EPQ allows students to go beyond the A level syllabus and course content. Students develop lifelong learning skills that prepare them for university and any future employment.
