Repton School Scholarships - Students Year 4-Year 7

Introduction:

I am pleased to confirm the launch of the scholarship application process for the academic year 2024/25.

Scholarships are awarded to suitable candidates [Internal and External] and are tenable for a student's time at school, subject to high standards of behaviour, performance and engagement in academic, musical and sporting activities, and at the discretion of the principal. Academic scholars should remain hard working and demonstrate outstanding attainment. Music scholars should support Repton School music performance groups; sports scholars should be available to represent school teams.

Scholarships will be offered in the following areas:

- **Academic**: awarded to students with the ability and commitment to be academic leaders at Repton. The school is looking for outstanding students, who are curious, inquisitive and enjoy their studies.
- **Music:** awarded to talented musicians who are prepared to make a strong contribution to the Music Department at Repton and prepared to support musical performance groups at the school.
- **Sport**: awarded to students with strong sporting credentials, who will promote sportsmanship, team work, leadership and fair play, and who will be ambassadors for Repton sports teams.

As part of the application process for sports scholarship, parents of internal and external candidates are required to provide evidence of their child's sporting ability, such as representation and success in sports teams and sports competitions. Priority will be given to internal and external candidates who demonstrate ability and participation in team sports, above that of individual sports or performance.

Selection:

On reviewing a scholarship application, candidates may be invited to attend an assessment at Repton. This will consist of an aptitude test, examination, or audition. There may also be an interview or activity designed to give candidates a chance to demonstrate their ability and aptitudes in Sport and Music.

The scholarship awards will be formally announced by Friday, 25th April 2024.
